



Wenrich "Nick" H. Green

December 8, 1935 - February 18, 2024

In the early hours of dawn, on February 18, 2024, Wenrich (Nick) Hofmann Green peacefully passed away at his home in Easton, MD, after a long courageous battle with Parkinson's Disease. His loving family was beside him. Nick was born December 8, 1935, to Dr. Zane A.W. and Stella (Hofmann) Green in Altoona, PA.

Nick graduated from Altoona High School and Lycoming College where he received his BA in Biology. He later received his Masters degree in Biological Science from The Pennsylvania State University, and completed additional graduate work in academic administration.

Nick began his career as a professor of biology at Lycoming College and was later employed by University of Maine as Associate Vice President. Upon his retirement, he was serving as Dean of Enrollment Management at the State University of New York, Binghamton.

A veteran of the U.S. Air Force, Nick served during the Korean War. He was made a Mason in Hiram Lodge, #616 in Altoona, PA, and was a member of the Williamsport, PA Consistory. Nick was a member of Christ Church, Easton, MD and for many years volunteered at the Chesapeake Maritime Museum. Nick was an active participant of the Parkinson's Disease support program, Rock Steady Boxing, at the Easton YMCA.

Nick is survived by his wife Susan (Farley); his son Lucas A. Green and wife Casie; his daughter Megan L. (Green) Shusko, her husband Robert, and Nick's wonderful grandchildren, Delaney, Aisley and Mitchelle; his sister and

brother-in-law, Beth and Douglas Dewhirst; and nieces, nephews and cousins. Services will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home in Easton, MD on March 2, 2024 at 11 AM, a half hour visitation will be prior to the service 10:30 AM - 11 AM. A private celebration of life will be held for family following the service.
