Wesley L. Russum of Chestertown, MD, died Sunday, February 15, 2004 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. He was 81.

Born September 12, 1922 in Queen Annes County, he was the son of the late Layton and Mamie Holden Russum. After attending school in Crumpton, MD, he worked with his father as a carpenter for several years. He was with the United States Army Medical Corp. serving from 1942- 1946 in the European Theatre in WWII. After returning from the war he married Lillian Cornell of Chesterville on May 20, 1946. Mr. Russum worked as a carpenter for several more years. In 1951 he went to work as a maintenance technician for Kent Concrete Ind., now Gillespie and Son's Concrete Inc. He retired from Gillespie and Son's in 1987.

He was a member of VFW Post 10063 J.T. Kilber Jr. Memorial Post.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Lillian Russum January 2, 2004 and a brother, Howard F. Russum.

Mr. Russum is survived by one daughter, Kathy Wiltbank of Chestertown, MD; two sons, Thomas W. Russum of Millington, MD and James R. Russum of Seaford, DE; four brothers, Ralph B. Russum of Chestertown, MD, John Calvin Russum of Crumpton, MD, Charles Edwin Russum of Queenstown,

MD and William A. Russum of Salisbury, MD; two sisters, Mary Dunning of Kenton, DE and Helen M. Barbosa of Chestertown, MD and three grandchildren.
