W. Franklin Moffett of Chestertown, Maryland, died Tuesday, December 12, 2006 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 100.

W. Franklin Moffett was born October 31, 1906 in Kennedyville, Maryland, the son of the late Walter and Mary Cooper Moffett. Mr. Moffett spent most of his life as a dairyman and farmer. From 1953 to 1956 he had the highest producing herd in Maryland.

Mr. Moffett was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown, Maryland, as well as a member of the vestry at St. Paul's Church. He was the director of Kent Co-op, Director of Kent Dairy Herd Improvement Association, the Chestertown Ruritans, and a 1922 Charter member of Kent 4-H Clover Calf Club. Mr. Moffett was a very avid bowler after retirement.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Moffett was preceded in death by two sisters: Elizabeth M. Crew and Ursula M. Wiest and three brothers: Harrison C. Moffett, Howard H. Moffett and Walter Moffett, Jr.

He is survived by his wife, Hazel Greenwood Moffett of Chestertown, Maryland; one daughter: Nancy Pope and her husband Curtis of Chestertown, Maryland; two grandchildren: Constance Rosa and her husband Matthew of Newark, Delaware and Heidi Barry and her husband Ryan of South Riding, Virginia; and one brother: George Robert Moffett of Chestertown, Maryland.
