Wilbur M. Carroll of Easton, MD died on Sunday February 29, 2004 at Genesis Elder Care-The Pines, Easton. He was 84.

Born December 12, 1919 in Easton, he was the son of the late Samuel G. and Myrtle V. McNeal Carroll. He was a 1936 graduate of Easton High School. In 1938 he joined the Maryland National Guard and in 1940 entered the U.S. Army as Staff Sgt. In October of 1942 he began overseas duty in Scotland and on D Day landed in Normandy France with the 29th Division.

In July of 1944 he was wounded in St. Lo France and in June of the same year, was wounded in Germany. After his release from active duty in 1945, he went to work for C&P Telephone in September of 1945 where he remained until his retirement October 1, 1982.

Mr. Carroll's wife, the former Peggy Ann Burton of Cambridge, whom he married November 2, 1945, died March 5, 2003.

A member of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, he was also a life member of E. E. Streets Memorial Post V.F.W. in Easton and the Telephone Pioneers of America.

Mr. Carroll is survived by his daughter, Gayla C. Strannahan and her husband Michael of Easton; two grandchildren, Lara Shaw Strannahan and Andrew

Bradford Strannahan. A brother, Charles A. Carroll is deceased.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, March 4, 2004 at 2:00 PM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton.

Private burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
