



Wilbur "Vince" Goddard

December 18, 1917 - May 21, 2011

Wilbur "Vince" Goddard of Easton died at William Hill Manor on May 21, 2011. He was 93.

Born in Roebling, NJ on December 18, 1917, he was the son of the late Wilbur S. and Ethel C. Foss Goddard. He began working for John A. Roebling & Sons Steel Mill in his hometown during WWII. On June 22, 1939, he married Bettie J. Keefe of Cleveland, OH, and they resided in New Jersey. After retiring from the steel mill, Mr. Goddard began a number of self-employed businesses. In 1974, he retired from Vince Goddard Fisherman Headquarters, located in Ship Bottom, NJ. He and his wife moved to a number of locations on the East Coast, and then settled down in Easton in 1997.

Mr. Goddard was a member of the Coates Masonic Lodge in Easton and St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Cordova. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening, decoy carving, and genealogy.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Goddard is survived by two sons, David V. Goddard of Surf City, NJ and Dennis L. Goddard of Easton; one daughter, Carole G. Pinto of Charlotte, NC; 5 grandchildren; and 7 great-grandchildren.

A service will be held at the graveside at 11:00 am on Thursday, June 23,

2011 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church Cemetery, Cordova.
