Wilda Carrol Raymond Smith Thomas died Thursday, February 22, 2007, after a brief illness. She was 80.

Born November 6, 1926 in Centreville (Digby) Nova Scotia, she was the daughter of the late Lemuel and Utah Raymond. She began her nursing education at the Oshawa Missionary College, Ontario, Canada. She then moved to the United States and Continued her education at the New England Sanitarium and Hospital in Melrose, Mass. Her nursing career included positions at the New England Sanitarium and Hospital; Washington Adventist Hospital, Takoma Park, Houton Memorial Hospital, Houlton, Maine; Mansfield Hospital, Mansfield, PA; Glendale Sanitarium and Hospital, Glendale, CA and Hadley Memorial Hospital in Washington, DC, where she held the position of director of nurses for 12 years.

She married James R. Smith in 1953 and had two children. On August 10, 1974 she married Howard Arnold Thomas of Chester. Wilda and Arnold traveled widely in the U.S. and Canada and were members of the Grasonville Seventh-Day Adventist Church, Grasonville and the Walker Memorial Seventh-Day Adventist Church, Avon Park, FL.

Mrs. Thomas was preceded in death by her husband, Howard Arnold Thomas on November 15, 1997. Wilda is survived by two brothers, Lester Raymond of

Digby, Nova Scotia and Randall Raymond of Quebec; a sister, Elizabeth of Boston, MA; a daughter, Sheila Case and her husband, David of Delta, OH; a son, Scott Smith of Westlake Village, CA; a stepdaughter, Alexis Thomas of Queenstown and a stepson, Charles A. Thomas and his wife, Dawn of Greensboro, MD. She also had five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

A Memorial Service will be held at 1:30 PM on Friday, March 2, 2007 at the Grasonville Seventh-Day Adventist Church.

A private graveside service will be held at the Stevensville Cemetery.
