Wilfred T. Azar died of natural causes on February 5, 2014, at the age of 96 at his home in Queenstown, MD. He was born February 13, 1917, in St. Catherine Ontario, Canada.

He is survived by his wife Mary Frances of 75 years; his children, Annee E. Azar, Wilfred T. Azar, Jr., and his wife Carol, Mary Frances Sergi and her husband Michael and H. James Azar; 12 grandchildren; 23 great-grandchildren; and 10 great-great-grandchildren.

He was a commercial real estate developer and was the founder, CEO, and Chairman of the Board of North Arundel Hospital currently known as Baltimore Washington Medical Center in Glen Burnie, MD, from 1958 - 1998.
