



Wilfred Leavitt McLeary

March 14, 1938 - December 21, 2015

Wilfred Leavitt McLeary of Stevensville, MD, passed away on December 21, 2015, after a brief illness at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 77.

Born on March 14, 1938, in Farmington, ME, the son of the late Robert and Laura McLeary, he grew up in Farmington and graduated from Farmington High School. Wilfred joined the Navy reserves and in 1955 enlisted and served two tours in Vietnam. After returning, he was stationed around the US and Europe including Rota Spain, Newfoundland Canada, Naples Italy, and Annapolis, MD. Upon retiring from the Navy in 1980, he moved to Stevensville and worked at the Naval Academy until 2003.

Wilfred loved to spend his summers in Maine on his beloved Clearwater Lake. He was a member of the American Legion; Fleet Reserve Club in Annapolis, MD, and Seabee's Retirees Gulfport MS. Wilfred was married to Dixie McLeary from 1959-1996.

He is survived by his daughters, Bethany Seward (Jonny) of Royal Oak, MD, Jessica Boehm (Eric) of Grasonville, MD, sister Nan Stanek (Bill) of Farmington, ME; and three grandchildren, Chris Arlt, Samantha Boyd, Maddie Boehm; several nieces and nephews; and his dog, Shotzy. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his brothers, Robert "Sonny" McLeary and Fred McLeary.
