Wilhelmus J. Vanderbyl died on Thursday, October 6, 2016, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton. He was 87.

Born on September 12, 1929, in Bovenkerk, Holland, he was the son of the late Petrus C. and Wilhelmina A. Vanderbyl.
