Willard Leiby Thompson of Chestertown, MD., died Friday, June 2, 2006 at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 75.

Mr. Thompson was born in Burrisville, MD on September 20, 1930 the son of the late Wilson Dewey Thompson and Edith A. Leiby. He attended Sudlersville High School and spent his early years working on the family farm.

On July 26, 1952 he married Barbara Kelley; they lived in Chestertown, Md.

Mr. Thompson served in the National Guard for ten years. He worked with the United States Government in Aberdeen, MD and later with Chestertown Shore Gas and Kent Gas for fifteen years.

Mr. Thompson was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Chestertown, MD, where he served on several boards; he also served on the board at Salem Church in Centreville, MD.

Mr. Thompson was a devoted member of Chester Lodge #115 A.F. & A.M. in Chestertown, MD, for 33 years. He was also a member of the York Rite, a past patron of The Order of the Eastern Star #86, and had received grand representative appointment from 1994-1996 from the Grand Chapter of Australia in MD. Mr. Thompson is survived by his wife Barbara Ann Kelley Thompson of Chestertown, MD., and one daughter, Lisa Ann Thompson of Vermont.
