



William "Billy" Dulin Foster

May 28, 1958 - June 27, 2015

"Billy" William Dulin Foster, of Centreville, MD, died Saturday, June 27, 2015, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 57.

Born May 28, 1958, in Easton, MD, he was the son of Gladys Spence Foster of Centreville and the late William Darwyn Foster.

Billy was a 1976 graduate of Queen Anne's County High School where he was active in sports. He played many years in the Queen Anne's County Men's modified softball league. He was also an accomplished outdoorsman. Billy managed a hunting property outside of Centreville. He was self-employed as a waterman, fisherman, and crabber on the Chester River. In the winter, he worked as a waterfowl outfitter. He was an exceptional waterfowl guide and was known as much for his outgoing personality and storytelling as he was for his hunting skills. He took great pride in helping and doing things for others. He made new friends everywhere he went. He would always say, "It doesn't cost anything to be nice to people." He had a positive attitude about life and people. He will be best remembered by those he met by his answer when asked, "How's it going?" It was always, "Every day's a good one."

In addition to his mother, Billy is survived by brothers, Michael Foster and his wife Lynn of Church Hill, Gary Foster and his wife Tina of Cordova; nieces, Laura Wienhold and her husband, Josh, and their daughter Kendall, Adrienne

Foster and her fiancé Derek Higby; Godparents, Gene and Lynda Palmatary; and half-sister, Kimberly Foster Diem and her husband Mitch.

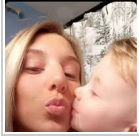
