William "Bud" Joseph Green of Chestertown, MD, died Sunday, January 23, 2011, at Washington Hospital Center. He was 88.

"Bud" Green was born August 1, 1922, in Baltimore, MD, the son of the late Frederick S. Green and Mary "Bosse" Green. Mr. Green served his country in the United States Army and was a WWII Veteran. He and his beloved wife of 64 years, Doris Wood Green, moved to Rock Hall in 1982. Mr. Green was a devoted member of St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall, MD. He loved wood working and decoy carving.
