William E. "Gene" Collier of Chestertown, MD died on Monday, May 26, 2003 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital. He was 73.

Born in Maryland on June 18, 1929, he was the son of the late William Clyde and Dora King Collier. He was a graduate of Stevensville High School, Class of 1946 and served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict. He was honorably discharged in December of 1954 after serving nearly seven years. Mr. Collier worked as a mechanic and truck driver before owning and operating his own business, G&E Quik Mart in Grasonville.

He was an active member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Chestertown, MD and attended Bay Pines Lutheran Church in Florida where he and his wife spent winters for the past nine years. He was the first Fire Chief of the Grasonville Volunteer Fire Department.

Mr. Collier is survived by his wife of 51 years, Ethel Collier; a son, Paul William Collier and his wife, Dayra of Tampa, FL; two daughters, Nancy Mench of Chestertown, MD and Doria Douglas and her husband, Joseph of Chestertown, and his extended family Wendy and Michael Moore of Chestertown, MD, a brother, Francis "Butch" Collier of Chester, MD; nine grandchildren, Michael Mansfield, Trish Bacon, Ericka Collier, Megan Moore, and Kaitlyn
