William Joseph Connor, Jr., of Hagerstown, MD, died into God's care on Friday, January 18, 2013. He was 66.

Born October 26, 1946, in Easton, MD, he was the son of Irma H. Connor and the late, William Joseph Connor, Sr. He grew up in Centreville and worked at his father's business "Connor's Pharmacy." He was a graduate of Centreville High School and then received a Bachelor of Arts degree from St. Bernard College in Cullman, AL.

In 1970, he moved to Hagerstown, MD, and became an executive with the Boy Scouts of America for 14 years. In 1984, he went to work for Lowes as Assistant Manager and head of the Tools Department for 25 years. In 1973, he married Laurie Dudley and they were devoted to each other in marriage for 37 years. They were member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church. She preceded him in death.

Bill served our country in the reserves for 12 years. He was a volunteer fireman for 10 years and was an avid sports enthusiast, with the Baltimore Colts, Orioles, and Ravens among his favorite teams. Bill enjoyed a model railroad collection as a hobby for many years.

In addition to his mother, Irma Connor of Easton, MD, he is survived by a

brother, Joseph M. Connor, Sr., and his wife, Bonnie of Centreville, MD; a sister, Jacquelyn C. Steuerman and her husband, Kenneth Steuerman of Timonium, MD; and nine nieces and nephews. A sister, Jeraldine A. Connor, preceded him in death in 2008.
