William Dwight Coursey, age 78, passed away Thursday January 18, 2024 at Complete Care Nursing & Rehabilitation Center in Annapolis, Maryland.

Dwight was born on September 18, 1945 in Stevensville, Maryland, to the late William R. and Isabel E. (Nee Hoxter) Coursey. He is survived by his loving wife of 56 years, Mary and their beloved daughter Brandie Coursey.

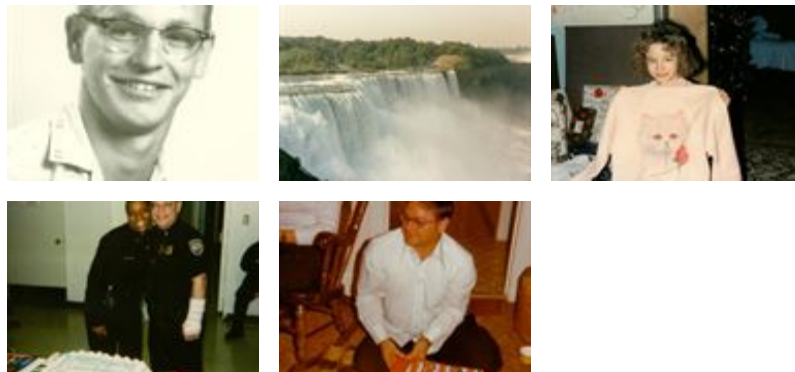
