William Alex Dadds, Sr. of Chester, MD died Saturday November 26, 2005 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 92.

Born on October 11, 1913 in Bryantown, Grasonville, MD, the son of the late Oscar Leon and Isabel DeLacy Dadds. As a young man, he worked as a waterman then served in the Army during World War II from April 2, 1942 to June 2, 1944 as a staff sergeant on a mine laying ship. After serving in the military, he worked as a farmer. Later, he became a carpenter and worked on such projects as the Bay Bridge, the Harbor Tunnel and several churches in Anne Arundel County. Mr. Dadds loved to hunt, fish and garden and loved singing.

Mr. Dadds is survived by two sons, William Alex Dadds, Jr. of Highlands, TX and Alan Daniel Dadds of Stevensville, MD; a sister, Eva Jones of Grasonville, MD; and three grandchildren. He is predeceased by his wife, Helania Staica Dadds, four brothers, Robert, Harry, Sammy and Roland; and one sister, Annetta Aaron.
