



## William Wilson Daffin

December 28, 1936 - September 14, 2024

Wilson Daffin passed away on September 14, 2024 at Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD surrounded by family, he was 87.

He was born December 28, 1936, son of the late William “Jim” B. Daffin and Bernice Olivia White in Easton.

Wilson graduated from Easton High School with the class of 1954. He served in the Army from 1956-1958 and upon returning home he worked for his family’s construction business for the remainder of his working days, eventually running and owning Frank E. 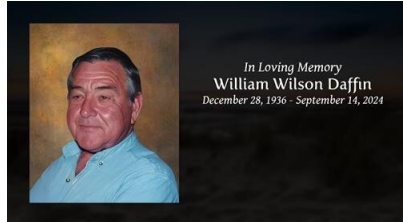
