William Merrill Dittrich of Harrington, DE, died Saturday, September 22, 2012, at Carroll Home Care and Hospice in Westminster, MD. He was 79.

William M. Dittrich was born May 25, 1933, in Wilkinsburg, PA, the son of the late, James Huey Dittrich and Elizabeth Richardson Dittrich. Mr. Dittrich was raised in Baltimore, MD, and enlisted in the U.S. Army in the early 50's.
