William Lewis “Lew” Dixon of Denton, MD, and formally of Sandtown, near Felton, DE, and Galena, MD, died on Friday March 10, 2017, in the Homestead Manor Assisted Living Facility in Denton, MD, where he has resided for the past four years. He was 93. Mr. Dixon was born near Millington, MD, the son of the late John C. and Myrtle King Dixon.

Mr. Dixon was a dairy farmer near Galena in Kent County, MD, for 20 years before retiring from milking every day to artificial breeding for Sire Power. Mr. Dixon loved to raise calves and cows, and he also enjoyed his flower and vegetable garden. Mr. Dixon was a former director for Southern States Coop. and for the Farm Bureau. He was for many years a very active member of the Sandtown Church of the Nazarene where he served as a Trustee, usher and collection assistant. Mr. Dixon was known as a devoted husband and father and was always willing to help anyone.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Dixon is predeceased by his wife, Marian Ruth Nyce Dixon in 1999, as well as one daughter, Ruth Dill; six brothers; and six sisters.

He is survived by four daughters, Betty Taylor of Laurel, DE, Fayth Dixon of Marydel, MD, Barbara Cole of Bruceton Mills, WV, and Theresa Dixon of Denton, MD; two sons, William Lewis Dixon Jr. of Ephrata, PA, and Timothy

Dixon of Montross VA; and one brother, Samuel Dixon of Townsend, DE; 13 grandchildren; and eleven great-grandchildren.

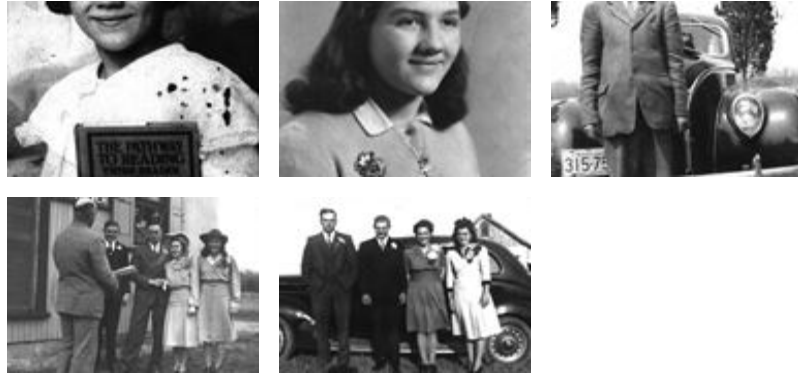
