



Rev. William "Bill" Dore

July 15, 1927 - December 28, 2017

Rev. William "Bill" Dore, of Rock Hall, MD, passed away on December 28, 2017, at Delaware Hospice Center in Milford, DE. He was 90.

Born on July 15, 1927, in Loomis, CA, he served in the Merchant Marines as a Seaman, during the final years of World War II. He worked as a painter and laborer on local Kent County Farms and was converted to Christianity on the Claude Moore Farm (an integral part of his life). Rev. Dore was called to the ministry, while working on the George Berger Farm in Tolchester, made public confession, and joined the Methodist Church at Rock Hall United Methodist Church.

In 1949, he married Ruth Collins and in 1950, they began serving Methodist Charges in Crapo, MD. They served churches and charges in both Maryland and Delaware, most recently as Associate Pastor in Rock Hall, MD.

Reverend Dore received a Bachelor's of Arts Degree in English Literature, Psychology, and Education from Washington College in 1955. He also received a Master's of Sacred Theology (THM) Degree from Temple University in 1958, a Master of Divinity (MDiv) Degree from Crozier Seminary in 1963, and served as a Fellow of Lancaster Seminary, where he completed two years toward his Doctoral Degree.

Reverend Dore served the Peninsula Conference on various boards and committees. He also served as Chaplain with numerous secular organizations, hospices, state police, fire departments, and Masonic orders. He also was involved as Scout master, Sea Explorer skipper, 4-H leader, and Commander of U.S. Coast Guard Flotilla 12-7. Rev. Dore was Past Master of Denton Lodge #128 AF&AM and worthy patron of OES Worcester Chapter in Snow Hill, MD. He enjoyed hiking the Appalachian Trail, boating, flying, and reading.

In addition to his wife, Ruth Dore, he is survived by two daughters, Ruth D. Story of Harrington, DE, and Kathy D. James of Seaford, DE; five grandchildren, Kathy Chambers of Bedford, VA, Karen Joiner of Harrington, DE, William Joiner of Lewes, DE, Jennifer Wright of Galena, MD, and John E. "Jack" Jones of Seaford, DE; eight great-grandchildren, Cody Chambers, Christopher Chambers, Ashley Smith, Rachel Smith, Donovan Peery, Hayden Thomas Peery, Benjamin Wright, Oliver Wright; and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, January 6, 2018, at Rock Hall United Methodist Church in Rock Hall, MD, where relatives and friends may call from 12:00 pm – 2:00 pm. Interment will be in Wesley Chapel Cemetery.

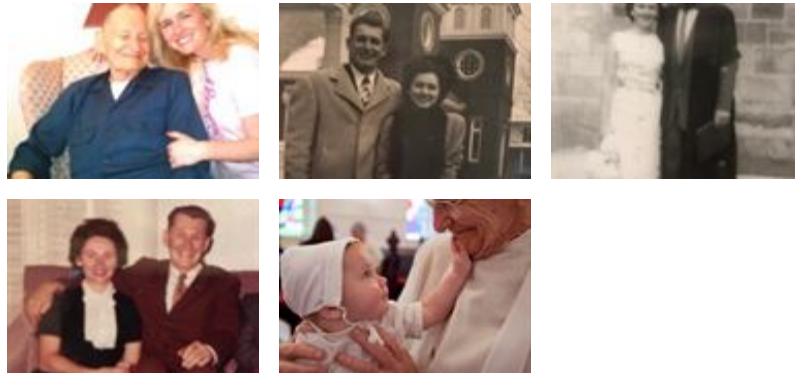

“ Dear Ruth and family-



There are two particularly poignant memories I have of Rev Dore, a humble, kind, powerful witness to the power and influence of Jesus Christ to anyone he encountered. When I think of the perfect pastor for pastors, I think of Bill Dore! Rev Dore was also a Biblical scholar of the highest order and loved teaching Greek!

The first remembrance I have is at Ebenezer United Methodist Church, Newark, DE. I was an atheist and a "Thomas the Doubter." Church sexton John Humpries, then Neighbors Wil & LaVerne Zimmerschied (another saintly couple) invited me to church. Bill greeted me and I told him I did not believe in God. He said he would be willing to talk with me about it, so for the next few months, we met every week and I brought a stack of books and a Bible and peppered him every meeting with questions I had. He was so honest, caring and accepting. I finally was saved after hearing Rev Dore preach in the 4th row, right hand pew in 1985 at Ebenezer. Rev Dore put his loving arms around me and said the angels were rejoicing over my salvation!! It was and still is the most important moment in my life and one I will carry to my heavenly home!

The other stories are of his living out the gospel. I told Rev Dore on a Sunday after church about a family friend visiting her children in Wilmington but she ended up near death of severe meningitis in St Francis Hospital. Rev Dore immediately offered to visit this lady after church. I told him she was Catholic and priests at St Francis would visit. That did not matter to him and he went to visit her! I met him at the hospital and he prayed with her. In the next few hours, she began to feel better. She became deaf in one ear but was able to go back home well in just a few days. The doctor did not understand how she could well so fast. I told Bill it was amazing she survived and Bill said when Catholics and Protestants work together for Jesus, there is no limit to what God can do (with his big smile) !!!! I think our dear Lord intervened after Rev. Dore's prayer!

He had a super sense of humor and when Rev George Goodley, Rev Tom Donnachie and Rev Bill Dore did a skit all dressed as the 3 angels, halo and all, at Christmas one year, it was so funny that we were laughing so hard, we were crying! What a joyful moment and I am sure the heavenly angels were smiling at their acting!!!

Thank you Bill for the memories, the prayers, the wonderful sermons, your Biblical knowledge and your Christ-like witness to those within and outside the church. Thank you Ruth and the entire Dore family for your many years of sacrifice of your time with Bill to serve Christ and for your loving and awesome support of his ministries.

Yes, Bill will be greeted in heaven by the Everlasting, loving arms of Jesus and say, "Well done, my dear and faithful servant." His legacy will live on if we act out our faith and serve especially those who do not know the love of Jesus! Rest in peace and may the Dore family know that the community of faith will surround them with love and caring too. God be with you always! Rev Dore, Phillipians 1:3! :)

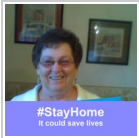
