William Nicholas “Bill” Favinger, II, 77, of Easton, MD, died on Friday, February 3, 2017, at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton. He was born on August 18, 1939, son of the late William Nicholas Favinger and Doris Selma Grupe.

Following his graduation from Easton High School in 1958, Bill entered the United States Air Force serving stateside in Kansas and abroad in Belgium. He was honorably discharged in 1964. Bill returned to Easton, and together with his father, Nick Favinger, worked in the shavings and sawdust industry, supplying product to local poultry houses, horse stables, and cattle compounds. Bill later worked for Southern States and was a foreman with Windy Hill Landscaping.

Mr. Favinger had a lifelong interest in raising animals. In his youth, he raised calves and pigs. As a teenager, he was an avid equestrian and cowboy at heart, owning many horses throughout his lifetime. In his retirement years, Bill raised sheep, goats, miniature donkeys, and unusual breeds of chickens. He and his wife together grew and enjoyed vegetable and flower gardening. In addition to his love of the outdoors, Mr. Favinger was an avid reader of anything related to the Civil War, Native Americans, the Wild West, and World War II.

Mr. Favinger is survived by his wife, Ginger Favinger of 37 years; children, Shelley Chance and Michael Favinger; stepchildren, Sean Lyons of Hochheim Am Main, Germany, Patrick Lyons of Hurlock, MD, Kathleen Warunek of Washington, DC, and Jeff Lyons of Harrisburg, PA; seven grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and two sisters, Pat Parks (Ellis) and Melinda Ewing (Tim), both of Easton, MD.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by an infant brother, Michael Anthony Favinger, who died in 1956.

A funeral liturgy will be celebrated on Wednesday, February 8, 2017, at 11:00 AM at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church, 1210 S. Washington St. in Easton. Burial will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park on Route 50 near Easton.
