William David Gaulden of Easton, MD passed away on Saturday, October 7th, 2023, at Talbot Hospice. He was 97.

Born on February 26th, 1926, in Spartanburg, SC he was the son of the late William Craig Gaulden and Lola Mae Johnson Gaulden.

Following High School, Dave joined the military serving both in the Army during World War II in the European theater and the Air Force during the Korean War. He graduated from Georgia Tech with a degree in Industrial Engineering and worked at several trucking companies, retiring from Preston Trucking as the Vice President of Maintenance. Dave enjoyed building and flying his airplane and working on his farm in Alabama. He was known for his kindness and strong Christian faith.

Dave is survived by his loving wife, Thelvia Woods Gaulden, to whom he was married for 72 years. He is also survived by his three children Jerry Gaulden (Lorrie), Donna Metzger (Paul), Linda Gaulden (Mark Lagowski), three grandchildren (David Gaulden, Eric Gaulden, and Robert Metzger), and two great grandchildren (Jaxson and Westley). In addition to his parents, Dave is preceded in death by his loving sister, Betty Gaulden Harris.

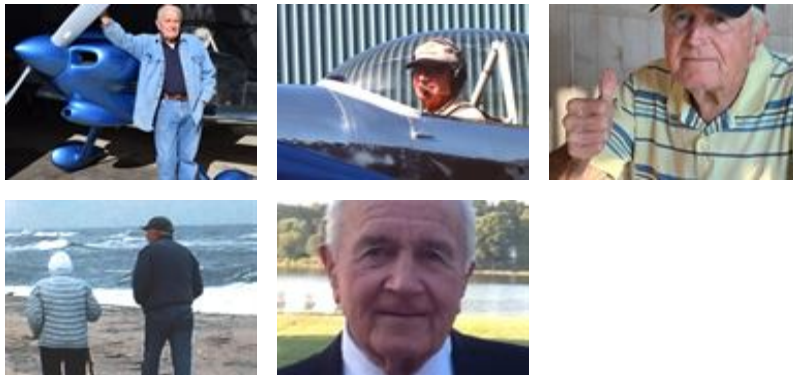
