



## William Randall Gerstmyer

William Randall Gerstmyer, 69, of Easton, MD, died peacefully at home on May 4, 2023. Born April 15, 1954, in Baltimore, he graduated from Towson High School and attended the University of Maryland.

He owned a food processing publishing company with his wife of 46 years, Nancy Judge Gerstmyer, and father-in-law, Arthur I. Judge, II. The publication began by Art's great-great-grandfather in 1878. Randy ran the publishing company alongside his father-in-law and wife until his illness struck in January 2009 causing the close of the business.
