William "Bill" E. Hudson of Stevensville died on June 21, 2001 at Future Care of the Chesapeake in Arnold. He was 90.

Born on April 24, 1911 in Baltimore, he grew up in Potomac, Maryland and would later enlist in the Army during WWII. After being discharged, he returned to Gaithersburg, and later to Rockville, where he worked as superintendent of the buildings of C.I. Mitchell and Best. He worked until he reached 70 years old. After retiring, he moved to Stevensville in 1985. He married the former Marilyn Ranew on April 13, 1968. Mr. Hudson was a member of the Methodist Church in Wheaton, the American Legion Post 278, the Bay Country Moose and Island Idlers. He loved to cut the grass, and made the best steamed crabs on the Eastern Shore.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Joan Gartrell of Rockville; a son, Dennis E. Hudson of Silver Spring; a step-son, John C. Lawlor; three step-daughters, Teresa A. Montana, Kathleen A. Gwynn and Lisa L. Mustakas; thirteen grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
