William Lucas Johnson died on November 29, 2002 at Heron Point in Chestertown, Md. He was 85. He was born in Shawnee, Oklahoma on June 28, 1917, and was the youngest of five children. He was preceded in death by his parents: the late David Halleck and Mary Olive Lucas Johnson. He and his three brothers often joined their father, a well-known Judge, for fishing and camping trips on the North Canadian River.

Married in 1941, Mr. Johnson moved to Duncan, Oklahoma to work for Halliburton Oil, and then to Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was recruited by the DuPont Company, and moved with his family to Wilmington, Delaware. He worked for the Chambers Works in New Jersey until his retirement in 1982. He and his wife Carolyn moved to Heron Point in 1991, and spent much of their time traveling in the US and Mexico. They were among the first residents at Heron Point. Mrs. Johnson died in 1997.

He is survived by his daughter, Susan Dowds, and her husband Philip, who live in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Mr. Johnson is also survived by several nieces.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, December 7, 2002 at 11:00 A.M. at Wesley Hall Heron Point in Chestertown, Md.. A private graveside service will be held at St. Paul's Cemetery. In lieu of flowers contributions may be
