William Jabez Jordan of Stevensville, MD, died Thursday March 16, 2017, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton, MD. He was 87.

Born on November 13, 1929, in Hobart, IN, the son of the late William Jordan and Hannah Walters. He grew up in Marley Creek, MD. Bill graduated from Glen Burnie High School. From 1951 – 1955, he served in the U. S. Navy during the Korean War. This is where he learned the skills of a barber. While in the Navy, he married Doris Elizabeth Walters in 1952. Returning to Marley Creek, MD, after his service, he began his career as a barber and also a custom home builder. Bill and Doris moved to Cape St. Claire, MD, where he operated a barber shop.

Bill and Doris moved their growing family in 1976 to Stevensville, MD. He operated as a general contractor trading as Jordan's Custom Builders until the late 1990's. After retiring as a contractor, Bill assisted with his son's business, Atlantic Shoreline until about 2010. He was a devoted member to the Kent Island First Baptist Church in Stevensville, MD, having built the church at the Stevensville location. Upon finally retiring in 2010, he devoted his time to his family and his 13 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

He is survived by his four children; JoAnne M. Jones (Morris) of Greensboro, William Douglas Jordan (Michele) of Goldsboro, Lyn Stup (Harry, Sr.) of

Stevensville, and Ms. Cassy Jordan of Chester. He was predeceased by his beloved wife, Doris in 2014.

A funeral service will be held 11AM on Tuesday March 21, 2017, at the First Baptist Church of Kent Island located at 300 State St., Stevensville, MD. Family and friends may visit one hour before the service at the church. Interment will follow the service at the Maryland Veterans Cemetery in Hurlock, MD.
