Denton: William Aquila Larrimore of Denton passed away on Saturday, September 17, 2011 at Homestead Manor. He was 95. Born on Wye Island, he was the son of the late Robert Russell Larrimore and Nellie Elizabeth Larrimore.

William served in the U.S. Army for four years in Northern France, Rhineland and Central Europe. He received three Bronze Battle Stars. After being honorably discharged, he began a career in farming. He retired from farming in 1978 and began working for the SHA. After his career with the State, he was hired by Hog Neck Golf Course and worked there until the age of 89. He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Virginia F. Larrimore of Denton; step-son, Larry F. Mueller and wife Diane of Easton; two grandchildren Tracy Mueller Smith and her husband Gregory of Frisco, Texas, Jeffrey Wade Mueller and his wife Melissa of Easton; and five great-grandchildren, Avery, Reagan, Jacob, Zachary and Allyson; two sisters Mildred Pauline Cooper and Mary L.
