



William "Eddog" Mullikin Jr.

August 10, 1944 - January 2, 2019

William "Eddog" Mullikin passed away on Wednesday, January 2, 2019, at his home. He was 74.

He was born on August 10, 1944, in Easton, MD, the son of the late William Edward Mullikin, Sr., and Ola Marie Caulk Mullikin.

Eddog was director of Talbot County Emergency Management, a lifetime member of the Easton Volunteer Fire Department, past president of the Delmarva Fireman's Association, and a member of the Red Knights.

He is survived by his daughters, Cheryl Mullikin of Tampa, FL, Holly Majka and her husband, Jeff of Washington, DC; and his friends in the firehouse community. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Janet Marie Mullikin.

A celebration of his life will be held at 2 PM, on Friday, January 11, 2019, at the Easton Volunteer Fire Department, 315 Aurora Park Dr., in Easton, where friends may call on Thursday, January 10, 2019, from 5 -7 PM. Burial will be private.

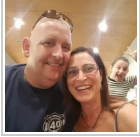
