William Edward Phillips of Bozman, MD, passed away on Saturday, April 14, 2018, at Bayleigh Chase Assisted Living in Easton, MD. He was 88.

He was born in Berwyn Heights, MD, to George S. Phillips and Alice Maude Brown on October 7, 1929. William was drafted into the United States Army and served in The Korean War. On September 1, 1951, he married Geraldine C. Wesley at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Laurel, MD. They made their home of forty years in Lanham, MD. He was a landscape supervisor for the National Park Service, after retiring William and Geraldine moved to Bozman in 1995. He was the founder and President of Custom Lawn Service Inc., from 1959 to present.

William was a lifetime member of the Phillips-Kleiner VFW Post 5627, the Loyal Order of Moose in Glen Burnie MD, Elks Lodge in Annapolis, MD, and an active member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton, MD.

He is survived by his wife, of sixty-six years, Geraldine; a son, William E. Phillips II (Penny) of Centreville, MD; a daughter, Cecilia Marie Maenner (Robert) of Mitchellville, MD; twelve grandchildren; and twenty great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, William was predeceased by sisters, Elizabeth

Gleason and Alice Catalono; and brothers, Paul, Stephen, Robert, Irvin, and Stanley Phillips.
