July 29, 1939 - October 3, 2012

William W. "Bill" Price, Sr., of Church Hill, MD, died Wednesday October 2, 2012, in the Hospice of Queen Anne's, Centreville, MD. He was 73.

Mr. Price was born in Kent County, MD, the son of the late Floyd C. and Grace Eva Carter Price.

Mr. Price retired from farming after many years in 2004. He also worked for Inter Sate Andesite of Delmar, MD., George & Lynch Construction of Dover, DE, and David A. Bramble Construction of Chestertown, MD. Mr. Price also worked with his brother Floyd Price for several years farming and water fowling in the 1970's.

In 1980, Mr. Price began a seasonal career by creating Bill Price Goose Hunting, which he enjoyed until he stopped commercial water fowling in 1995.

Mr. Price was a member of the Queen Anne's County Farm Bureau. He loved to hunt deer, and really enjoyed hunting rabbits with his dogs. From a very early age, he enjoyed hunting coons with his dogs. He also enjoyed raising geese from a very early age.

Mr. Price is survived by his wife of 55yrs, Elsie Lucille Price; two sons, William W. Price, Jr., and Edward A. Price both of Church Hill, MD; brother, Floyd W. Price of Kennedyville, MD; one sister, Ann P. Thorpe of Hurlock, MD; one

grandson, William W. Price, III; one granddaughter, Kristin Renee Price; and one great- granddaughter, Julia Renee Price.

He is predeceased by two sisters, Lynn Gustafson and Patricia Eva Lee Newton.

Funeral services will be held on Sunday, October 7, 2012, at 2 p.m. at Fellows Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road in Chestertown, where friends and family may call after 12 p.m.

Interment will be in Sudlersville Cemetery, Sudlersville, MD.
