William H Quigley, III, of Chestertown, MD, died peacefully at home while surrounded by his family on November 4, 2013. He was 79.

He was born in Camden, NJ, and raised in National Park and Pitman, NJ. He graduated from Pitman High School in 1952, where he ran track and medaled at the Penn Relays. He served in the US Air Force for four years and then studied at Temple and Drexel Universities.

He had a long and successful career as a technical sales manager while raising his family with his wife, Barbara, in Doylestown, PA. He was a past president of the Corvette Club of Delaware Valley and enjoyed playing tennis, sailing the Chesapeake Bay, and listening to the music of Frank Sinatra. In retirement, he was active with the Sultana Projects and the Lions Club in Chestertown and was a member of the Rock Hall Yacht Club and Rock Hall Sailing Club.

He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Barbara; his sons, William IV (Stacey) of Weston, CT, and Jeffrey (Pamela) of Doylestown, PA; his daughter, Joy (Peter McDonald) of Fresno, CA; and his grandchildren, Eric and Caroline. He is also survived by his brothers, George of Treasure Island, FL, and David of Graham, NC, and his sister, Margaret of Pitman, NJ.

A memorial service will be held at 12 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam in Chestertown on November 23.
