William Herman Reinbold of Chestertown, MD, died November 30, 2018, at his home. He was 92.

He was born in Williamsport, PA, on March 10, 1926, the son of the late George W. and Emma Pearl Schram Reinbold. He served his country in the U.S. Navy and was a Purple Heart Recipient.
