William Donald Reiser of Easton, MD, died on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, at his home. He was 74.

He was born in Altoona, PA, on January 12, 1940, to the late Helen C. Malligan and Carl A. Reiser.

Mr. Reiser spent his childhood in Hollidaysburg, PA, then served in the Army from 1962 to 1965.
