William H. (Bill) Sard, Sr., of Trappe, MD, died at Talbot Hospice House in Easton on Tuesday, January 23, 2018. He was 80. He was born in Hurlock, MD, on December 9, 1937, the son of the late Earl Sard and Catherine Sard of Trappe.

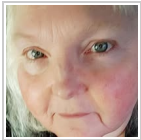
