



## William Eugene Schisler

November 8, 1921 - October 28, 2011

William E. Schisler, 89, of Bozman, MD, formerly of Baltimore, passed away Friday, October 28, 2011, at the V.A. Hospital in Baltimore.

Mr. Schisler was born November 8, 1921. He was the son of the late, Charles and Mabel Schisler. He served his country as a member of the Army Air Force in the European Theatre during WWII. He drove a two and a half ton truck hauling gas and bombs from a supply depot to the airfield. Upon returning from the service, he owned and operated his own ice business delivering to taverns in Baltimore. He then took a position as a warehouse supervisor with B. Green and Company, retiring in 1983.

Mr. Schisler moved to the Eastern Shore where he fulfilled a lifelong dream of living on the water, owning a boat, fishing and crabbing. His greatest joy was his family.

He is survived by his wife of 69 years, Regina (Zacharko) Schisler; seven children, William L. (Ruth), David (Nancy), Kathleen McConnell (Michael), John (Mary), Dianna Hambleton (Todd), Margaret Hajiantoni (Pete), Jerome (Donna); sixteen grandchildren; and sixteen great-grandchildren. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his siblings, Dorothy Faulhaber and Charles, Robert and Francis Schisler.
