Bill Seeds was born in Lutherville, MD, on October 9, 1929. He attended Towson High School and Towson State College.

He worked for 40 years for the Maryland National Guard, and he was a full Colonel when he retired in 1985.

Bill moved to Prospect Bay in March of 1987, and he was typically found on the golf course. Bill's other interests included boating and church. He helped start Safe Harbor Presbyterian on Kent Island, where he was an elder and on the Building Committee.

Bill passed away on Saturday, January 27, at home, surrounded by his family. Bill is survived by Dot Seeds, who he was married to for 65 years. He is also survived by three children, eight grandchildren, and ten great-grandchildren.
