



William Patrick Shakespeare

September 26, 1927 - February 16, 2015

A Funeral Liturgy for William P. Shakespeare of Westborough, MA, formerly of Easton, MD, and Old Greenwich, CT, will be celebrated at Saint Joseph's Mission Church, 13209 Church Lane, Cordova MD, on February 21 at 10:30am. Mr. Shakespeare died peacefully at the Beaumont Nursing Home, February 16, 2015. He was 87 years old.

Born in Great Neck, NY, September 26th, 1927, he was the son of the late William and Dorothea Shakespeare. He worked as a Vice President of Bowne Company, a global financial, marketing and business communications firm. He married Anne Marie Chrisman in July of 1960. They made their home in Old Greenwich, CT.

Since moving to Easton in 1992, he had been a member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton, Talbot Country Club and served as an active participant in the Talbot Mentoring Program in Easton, MD.

He was predeceased by his wife, Anna Marie, and is survived by his two daughters, Catherine Shakespeare of Branford, CT and Judith Shakespeare-Siano of Pennington, NJ; a son, William C. Shakespeare of Southborough, MA; and three grandchildren, Victoria, Jonathan and Isabelle Shakespeare. Burial will be at St. Joseph's Catholic Cemetery, Cordova, MD.
