Queenstown, MD: William Edward Shortall passed away at Easton Memorial Hospital on May 13, 2007. He was 74.

William was born in Easton, MD on July 10, 1932. He was the son of the late Francis Edwin Shortall, Sr. and Eda Bailey. A graduate of Centreville High School, William served in the Navy during the Korean War. After being discharged, he entered Washington College in Chestertown, MD where he earned his BS Degree, followed by his Masters Degree from the University of Pennsylvania. He was math and physics teacher at Lansdowne High School and a past president of the Teachers Association of Baltimore County, 1970 - 1972. Upon retirement, in 1987, he moved to the Eastern Shore of MD. He was an avid reader, golfer and enjoyed cooking.
