William H. "Bee" Slagle of Chestertown, MD died on October 4, 2001 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital in Chestertown. He was 69.

Born in Chestertown, MD on March 18, 1932, he was the son of the late William E. and Anna M. Slagle.

Mr. Slagle graduated from Chestertown High School and served in the U.S. Army in the Korean Conflict from 1952 until 1954, when he was honorably discharged at the rank of Sgt. Among the metals he received was the bronze star. After his discharge he returned to Chestertown, MD and worked at Washington College until he received a position at the Chestertown Bank of Maryland where he worked for nearly 30 years and retired as head cashier. He was an avid bowler in his younger years and loved to travel, especially to Las Vegas.

He was preceded in death by his mother and father and a brother, Lawrence E. Slagle.

He is survived by a brother Walter E. Slagle of Chestertown, MD; 2 nieces, Gay and Julie Slagle and a nephew Larry Slagle.
