William Bayard Sutton of Chestertown, MD died on Monday, December 20, 2010 at his home. He was 96 years old.

He was born on December 9, 1914 and was raised on the Alms House Farm in Chestertown, MD, where he raised prize winning chickens and tomatoes. He was the son of the late, Joseph B. and Myrtle Durdling Sutton. Mr. Sutton graduated Class of 1931 from Chestertown High School. A few years after graduation, he married Isabel Brice on November 2, 1935. Mr. Sutton worked as an engineer with C & P Telephone Company and after over 35 years, retired in 1980.

Mr. Sutton was an avid hunter and enjoyed spending time at the beach whether in Ocean City, MD during the summer and spending the winter months in Florida. He loved collecting antiques, photography, restoring brass floor lamps, and especially his gardens, both floral and vegetable. He was a member of the Chester Lodge #115 A.F & A.M., in Chestertown, MD.

He was predeceased by his wife of 67 years in 2002 and his grandson, Franklin D. Miller III.
