William John “Bill” Weisman of Royal Oak, MD, formerly of Baltimore, MD, died at his home on Monday, December 29, 2014, surrounded by his family. He was 86 years old.

Born in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of Raymond F. and Mary Chalmers Shaw Weisman. He graduated from Poly Technic Institute High School, The University of Maryland, College Park with a degree in Business, and Johns Hopkins University with a degree in Engineering. On June 29, 1957, he married Beatrice J. Tuthton. They made their home in Baltimore County for 35 years.

Bill worked for Lloyd E. Mitchell, Inc. and Henry Adams, Inc. engineering firms before opening Weisman Incorporated, an HVAC testing and balancing firm in 1965. Bill was Past President of the Associated Air Balance Council, and the Baltimore Chapter of the American Society of Heating Refrigeration Air Conditioning Engineers, ASHRAE. He was also an integral part of Chesapeake Testing and Balancing Engineers in Easton, MD. Bill and Betty moved to Royal Oak in 1992 where they resided together, enjoying their retirement, family and friends.

In addition to his wife, Beatrice, he is survived by his children, Christian (Jean) of Easton, MD, Joseph (Cynthia) of Timonium, MD, David (Karen) of Royal

Oak, MD, and Mary Lisa (Stan) of Chestertown, MD. He is survived by 12 loving grandchildren, Jessica and Megan Weisman, Steuart, James, and Joseph Weisman, Molly, William and Sam Weisman, and Sarah, Catherine, Hannah and Jacob Kilby, and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by a brother Raymond F. Weisman.
