William A. Eason, a fifty-six year resident of Trappe Station, died on Friday, September 26, 2003 at Genesis Elder Care-The Pines. He was 90.

Born February 4, 1913 in Oxford, MD, he was the son of the late Milton and Nettie Willey Eason. After attending public school in Talbot County, he began a lifelong career in farming, from which he retired in 1978.

In September 1935, he married the former Evelyn L. Harrison. Mrs. Eason died on August 18, 1999.

He was a member of the Talbot County Farm Bureau.

Mr. Eason is survived by three daughters, P. Joan Hogge of Gloucester Point, VA, Carolyn E. Stewart of Woolford, MD and Shirley L. Johnson of Easton, MD; two sons, William L. Eason and Richard W. Eason, both of Oxford; four sisters, Betty Miller of Allentown, PA, Pearl Pritchett of Cambridge, Margaret Tennant of Newcomb, and Naomi Behrens of Cordova; one brother, Robert Eason of Darien, GA; fourteen grandchildren and seventeen great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by two sisters, Helen Hicks and Mary Harrison; two brothers, Raymond Eason and Edward Eason; and four grandchildren.
