He worked as a night desk clerk for Imperial Hotel in Chestertown before starting his own business "The Taxi Man". He was a member of Ramsey Golf and Country Club and India House, NY. He enjoyed golf and reading. He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church.

In addition to his wife, Marion Miller McAuliffe, he is survived by two sons, Christian McAuliffe of Estero, FL, William McAuliffe III of New Orleans, LA; four daughters, Tara Brown of Baton Rouge, LA, Kathy Hoffman of Baton Rouge, LA, Karen Craney of Poolesville, MD, Kyle van de Poll of Medina, OH, and seven grandchildren. A sister, Lowry Arata, predeceased him.
