



## William A. McClyment

William A. "Bill" McClyment of Bradenton, FL died on Tuesday, April 20, 2004. He was 88.

Born July 31, 1915 in Centreville, MD, he was the son of the late William A. and Esther Capel McClyment. A 1933 graduate of Centreville High School, he enlisted in the Civilian Conservation Corps in July of 1934, where he remained until 1937 when he moved to Wye Mills to be with his mother and three younger siblings. In 1942 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and attended school in Baltimore for nine months before reporting for basic and advanced training at Camp Crowder, Missouri. He served with the 294 Joint Assault Signal Company in England and France before returning to the U. S. on December 27, 1944. After further training in California, he shipped across the Pacific to Oahu and was on a Preparation of Alert Movement when Japan Surrendered. After his release from active duty, he returned to work for the Soil Conservation Service, retiring in October of 1971 after thirty years of service. In May 1972 he moved to Bradenton, FL where he remained until the time of his death.

In May of 1947, Mr. McClyment married the former Marie Moyer. She died January 9, 1986. In 1988 he married the former Marguerite Sparks who died January 11, 1995.

Mr. McClyment is survived by a brother, Robert W. McClyment of Grasonville, MD; a sister, Libby Barton of Tilghman, MD; a step-daughter, Barbara George of Greensboro, MD; a step-son, Charles Sparks of Davidsonville, MD; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by two brothers, George E. McClyment and J. Henry McClyment; and a sister, Frances McClyment.

A graveside service will be held on Friday, April 30, 2004 at 10:30 AM at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
