William "Bill" Slot, a long time resident of Kent Island and a native of The Netherlands died on March 7, 2002 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 92.

Mr. Slot and his family immigrated to the United States in 1947 to start a new life in the country he loved. Mr. and Mrs. Slot became American Citizens at Centreville in 1955. He was active in farming in Queen Anne's County, and later worked for the U.S. Department of Agriculture in Beltsville, Maryland. He retired to Kent Island in 1974. Mr. Slot was a member of the Christian Reformed Church in Washington, D.C., and was active in the U.S. Naval Academy Chapel Midshipman support program for a number of years. He was also active for many years in community service, and was a Meals-on-Wheels volunteer until just a few years ago. In 1993, he was honored by the State of Maryland for his volunteer work by being recognized as the Queen Anne's County recipient of the Maryland You Are Beautiful Award.

Mr. Slot is survived by his wife of 66 years, Alice Slot; four sons, Peter of Houston, Texas, Jacob of Fort Myers, Florida, Arie of Mahwah, New Jersey, and Parke of Chester, Maryland; six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
