William "Bill" Edward Spink died on October 3, 2000 in The Schuyler House in Church Hill, Md. He was 89.

Mr. Spink was born in Philadelphia, Pa. on November 11, 1910, the son of the late John and Anna Simon Spink. At the young age of 16, Mr. Spink worked delivering lumber by horse and wagon. He later trained and was a cloth cutter by trade. He also worked in construction and as a store clerk. He was a volunteer fireman, and was instrumental in forming the Almonesson Fire Company in Almonesson, New Jersey.

After retirement in 1974, Mr. Spink worked for National Park in Red Bank, New Jersey. He enjoyed boating, woodworking, and big band music. He was preceded in death by his wife: the late Anna Blanche Gross, who died in 1992. He was also predeceased by a sister: Mary, a brother: John, and an infant great grandson: Henry Jasper Knag.

He is survived by a daughter: Joan Crawford of Chestertown, Md., a granddaughter: Melanie Crawford of Hillsdale, New York, and 3 great grandchildren: Radha Crawford, Everett Knag, and David Knag all of Hillsdale, New York.
