William Joseph Bussells, III of Rock Hall, Maryland died on July 5, 2008 at his home. He was 41.

Born in Baltimore, Maryland on May 30, 1967, he was the son of William Joseph II and Cynthia Dixon Bussells of Rock Hall, MD. He resided in Glen Burnie, Maryland until moving to Rock Hall in 1980. Billy attended school in Rock Hall and graduated from Kent County High School in 1986, where he achieved special recognition in auto mechanics. He worked on the water during his high school years and continued as a self employed waterman. He worked during the winter months as a painter, carpenter, and auto mechanic.
