William C. Storey died January 2, 2007, with his wife and children at his side.

He was born in Peekskill, New York, April 20, 1927, the son of the late William H. and Lillian Smyth Storey, who both immigrated from Ireland. He was raised in Eastchester, New York, where he graduated from High School. He earned his engineering degree from New York University.

During the Korean War, he served at Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland. Most of his professional career was spent with General Foods Corporation. He worked in operations at plants in Battle Creek, Michigan; Kankakee, Illinois; and Dover, Delaware, before returning to Corporate Headquarters in White Plains, New York. He then spent five years in Brussels, Belgium as Operations Director of the General Foods International Division. After returning to the U.S., he became Vice President of the Gaines Division of General Foods. He retired in 1987 from Quaker Oats Corporation after a buyout situation, and moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland.

Bill was an avid boater and belonged to the Miles River Yacht. He enjoyed building Habitat for Humanity houses, working with the Thursday Crew until he was physically unable to do so. He and his wife of 56 years loved to travel and made extensive trips throughout the world. Above all, he loved to have his children and grandchildren for family get-togethers.

He is survived by his wife, Jo Ann; son Bill Storey, Jr. and wife Anne of Annapolis, MD; son Tim and wife Julie of Fairfax, VA; son, Tom and wife Jane of Herndon, VA; daughter Ann Kumpf and husband Mike of Finksburg, MD; and eight grandchildren. He was predeceased in death by his brother James.

He was a member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church in St. Michaels. Burial will be in Hartsdale, New York. A memorial service will be held in St. Michaels at a later date.
