William “Butch” Marsey, Jr. of Chestertown, MD died on Tuesday March 30, 2010 at his home. He was 82.

He was born on June 7, 1927 in Yorklyn, De, the son of the late, William Dodd Marsey, Sr. and Sophie Ring Marsey. Mr. Marsey enlisted into the U.S. Navy in his eleventh year of high school. He served in the Pacific Theatre during World War II and was honorably discharged. Upon his return he completed his high school education and married Nancy Brittingham on October 10, 1947, they lived in Yorklyn, DE where he worked as an electrician with the N.V.F. Company. After 39 years, Mr. Marsey retired, then he and his wife moved to Tolchester, their summer home for many years. “Mr. Bill” began a second career with Washington College in the Athletic Department from 1983 to 1996.

He was a member of the Sgt. Preston Ashley American Legion Post 228 in Rock Hall and the V.F.W. in Millington. Mr. Marsey enjoyed cutting grass, his pets and spending time with his family.

He was predeceased by a daughter, Patricia McMahon in 2009.

In addition to his wife, Nancy, he is survived by a daughter, Jeannine Marsey and her husband, Carlo Fernandes of Rock Hall, MD; a son-in-law, Richard McMahon of Chestertown, MD; grandchildren, Darek McMahon and Carlo

Fernandes, Jr. Also survived by a dear friend, Sue Brown.

The family will be receiving friends and family at the Delaware Veteran's Memorial Cemetery, 2465 Chesapeake City Rd., Bear, DE 19701, on Friday, April 9th, after 12:30PM where honors will take place promptly at 1:15PM.
