William Edward Dill of Wye Mills, MD died on Wednesday, December 8, 2004 at Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD. He was 86.

Born in Centreville on September 14, 1918, he was the son of the late William Dill and Della Lister Dill.

He attended school in Centreville. He worked on the farm with his father until he was drafted in 1941 and served as Tech Sergeant during World War II. His medals and honors he received included The Purple Heart, Good Conduct Medal with clasp, American Defense Service Medal, European-African Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon, Asiatic-Pacific Theater Ribbon, American Theater Ribbon, WW II Victory Ribbon, expert Infantry Badge and Sharpshooter MI. Following his discharge he and Don Andrews were partners in a custom farming business. In 1959 he purchased a farm in Starr, MD where he lived and worked until retiring in 1998 when he moved to Wye Mills, MD.
